Did you know that the new Waste Water Treatment Plant (WWTP) is estimated to cost \$700M?

Assuming we successfully acquire matching Federal and Provincial grants totalling \$466M, Metro Vancouver municipalities will still be required to fund the final \$233M through utility fees.

Of the remaining \$233M, the three North Shore municipalities will directly pay 30%. The North Shore's share will be approximately \$70M.

We will also pay our proportionate share of the \$163M Metro component. The North Shore's share of the Metro component, an additional \$11M, brings our total share to \$81M. City taxpayers will pay approximately \$23.2M of the total WWTP cost.

The annual tax implication to each North Shore resident is estimated at \$100 per person, per household starting in 2016, and rising to a little over \$200 per person, per household by 2021.
