


ATTENTION ATTENTION ATTENTION

It has now been reported that on Friday November 14th 2014, persons entering North Vancouver City Hall for the purposes of Advance Voting, upon entering the Atrium on the main upper floor entrance off of the 14th Street Plaza, were being approached by a male who handed each person a list of names for whom he suggested each voter cast their vote. The list was type written on a slip of paper approximately 3" x 3" square.



It has been reported that this individual (male) who is a City employee, works at the North Vancouver City Library.

The list of names being distributed by the aforementioned person was the full list of 'Slate' candidates proposed and endorsed by Mayor Mussatto.

The fact this activity had occurred was disclosed to the City of North Vancouver's Chief Electoral Officer on Election Day, November 15th 2014. An actual original copy of the candidate list being circulated was hand delivered to the Chief Electoral Officer on Election Day, which delivery was witnessed by the City's senior security staff member who was present at the time of the delivery.

It is illegal to distribute election materials, advertisements, or promote any specific candidate or group of candidates within 100 Meters of a polling station on any day when polling (voting) is underway. Thus the aforementioned activity was illegal.

We are asking anyone who was approached while entering or passing through City Hall or North Vancouver City Library, on any of the Advance Polling dates (November 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 12, 13, or 14), who was specifically asked to vote for a particular candidate or group of candidates, orally or in writing, to come forward and report this activity. It does not matter whether the individual making the request was a City employee or a third party.

If on Election Day (November 15th, 2014), you were approached prior to entry into a City of North Vancouver polling station) and while you were within 100 meters of that polling station, asked to vote for any specific candidate or group of candidates, either orally or in writing, that you report this fact.
