Dear Kerry Morris:

Thank you for providing more information in your email response dated April 28, 2015.

The corporate registry notice you attached indicates that K & A Projects (PGI) Ltd. amalgamated with Playtime Community Gaming Centres on October 7, 2012, not K&T Properties Ltd. as you state in your email. Darrell Mussatto has disclosed an in-kind contribution from K&T Properties, which was the subject of your original complaint. You have not provided any evidence to show that K&T Properties no longer exists as a company. Further, our own search of the corporate registry indicates that K&T Properties Ltd. is still an incorporated company in British Columbia separate from Playtime Gaming Centres Inc.

Additionally, Mr. Mussatto has clarified that the phone bank provided by K&T Properties was separate from his Burnaby phone bank that he shared with Craig Keating and Kathy McGrenera. Both are included as election expenses under the “research and polling” category in his disclosure statement.

Regarding your further concern that councillors Craig Keating, Linda Buchanan and Holly Back each only disclosed receiving a contribution of \$921.16 from K&T Properties Ltd., we will follow up on this during our compliance reviews of those files to ensure this value accurately reflects the portion of the total phone bank donation that was used by each of their campaigns.
