5 working days ago I attended City Hall at which time I personally delivered into your hands an envelope containing three separate FOI's.

In those FOI's, and in the oral conversation which ensued, I identified that I first wished to view the materials before placing a photocopy order. While I was quite clear in regards to my document specifications, all of which were standardized accounting reports from the City's regular financial reporting systems, I was concerned that a simple request without first viewing the materials, may lead to the provision of massive amounts of irrelevant materials, which has been the justification previously employed on two other occasions to price provision of those materials out of reach.

As the documents sought are all current, and are available to staff on enquiry taking moments, not hours, at the push of a button, I am wondering why I have yet to receive confirmation of receipt of 1). my FOI delivery, and 2). the timeline in which I will be given access to these materials. Please accept this email as my formal enquiring as to when I might receive a response to these two items, and on what date(s) I may attend City Hall to conduct the visual review of the documents in accordance with the law?
